Social activities

- Purely social occasions
- Maybe a dance concert
- A forum where we could get to know each other

Passing on what we know

- Opportunity for talented professionals to teach
- I am hoping we will get good specific requests from younger clinicians
- ... and offerings from senior clinicians
- Professional meetings presented by senior clinicians @ low/no fee
- Analytic concepts with conflicting perspectives

Types of offerings

- More classes (x2)
- More trainings
- Seminars
- Book Study Groups
- More opportunities for special topic seminars (4-6 sessions)
- More talks – specifically on practice and technique
- Establishing ongoing case consultation & reading groups
- Consult group for child therapy
- Cont. Ed. & Professional Enrichment activities on different nights of the week
- Sponsoring the return of “Luminous Psyche” (done by COR before, I think)

Certificate Program

- Year-long training
- Certificate Program in psychoanalytic psychotherapy that embraces all forms of psychoanalytic theory and practice
- May want to create another “Master Clinician Series”
- Series of classes or certificate program, e.g. child therapy training opportunities

Specific program or topic requests and old ideas revisited

- [More] “Nuts & Bolts”
- Perhaps a class on frame issues
- A panel of gender identity, including: transgender identities
- I am interested in attachment (separation anxiety) & substance abuse
- Cover recent ideas on gender development
