- To support, sponsor, or cosponsor educational programs for the benefit of professions interested in psychoanalytic theory.
- To promote dissemination of information regarding psychoanalytic offerings through newsletters, bulletins, or other appropriate means.
- To enhance possibilities for relating to local and national organizations that represent many aspects of the psychoanalytic community.
- To facilitate and encourage a full range of training opportunities in psychoanalytic theory and practice.

Activities

Newsletter

The quarterly *Alliance Forum*, a place to present your ideas and read those of others, a calendar of psychoanalytic events, conference and book reviews, and more.

Professional Meetings

Regular evening meetings providing opportunities for presentation and discussion of psychoanalytic thought.

Educational Courses

A variety of offerings each quarter, including clinical case conferences.

Special Events

Alliance Community Psychotherapy Clinic
